VADM Regina M. Benjamin, MD, MBA is the 18th Surgeon General of the United States. From her early days as the founder of a rural health clinic in Alabama to her leadership role in the worldwide advancement of preventive health care, Dr. Benjamin has forged a career that has been recognized by a broad spectrum of organizations and publications.

She currently serves as chairman of the National Prevention Council, making her the first U.S. Surgeon General in history to bring together seventeen federal agencies to develop a National Prevention Strategy.

Dr. Benjamin has a B.S. in chemistry from Xavier University, New Orleans, an M.D. degree from the University of Alabama at Birmingham and an MBA from Tulane University. She attended Morehouse School of Medicine and completed her family medicine residency in Macon, Ga. Dr. Benjamin holds 15 honorary degrees.
