

TRTC - Regular Meeting – 4 April 2011

President Dilys Bowman called the meeting to order at 7:30.

Minutes for March reviewed and approved by voice vote.

Treasurer's report for March reviewed and approved by voice vote.

Marathon Report: Late start due to bus problems, noise complaints at Pittard Sears, runners on left side of ATT south of Scott King. All of these concerns will be addressed and adjustments made for next year.

Herndon Park Connector: Contractor who built the Lawson Street connector has been contacted. Concrete will be preferred over asphalt.

Durham Phase E and I-40 bridge: Permit approval still moving forward.  
Durham Beltline: nothing new to report.

Chatham County - "No Parking" signs have been installed on O'Kelly Chapel, New Hope Church Road, and Pittard Sears Road. Pittard Sears is not supposed to have the signs – negotiations for removal underway.  
Rosemont residents are opposed to parking on O'Kelly Chapel Road.

Water on ATT at Pittard Sears: Cary Site Plan Approval may cost \$500 or more.  
Tap fee may be \$1100.

Discussion of projects for Grant Proposals: Parking Lot and Water at Pittard Sears;  
Herndon Park Connector; Informational Kiosks.

Fayetteville Road Trailhead: Sign posts need to be replaced with better posts and put in concrete.

Our TRTC trademark needs to be renewed.

Bob Kruhm explained the "Bull City Open Streets" events planned for Durham in May, June, September and October. It was decided to participate in the events.  
Motion to allocate \$250 for TRTC Sponsors passed by voice vote (motion by Curt Devereux, second by Bob Salano).
