

TRTC - Regular Meeting – 6 June 2011

President Dilys Bowman called the meeting to order at 7:30.

Durham Phase E and I-40 bridge: Pre-Bid Meeting scheduled for 16 June 2011. Construction may start by late 2011 or early 2012.
