Triangle Rails-To-Trails Conservancy, the folks that brought you the **American Tobacco Trail** several years before the local municipalities finished the job, has taken the responsibility of maintaining this trail, the Eagle Spur Trail.

As you have no doubt noticed these three big culverts near the end of the trail are either washed out or seriously deteriorating. This represents a safety hazard and inconvenience to trail users. The lake level doesn't have to be up more than a foot or so from normal level before the end of the trail is cut off by the washouts.

Because there is no access for or availability of any kind of heavy equipment the existing culverts will have to be dug out by hand and the replacements installed the same way. We will also have to remove trees, stumps, and roots that will impede or restrict water flow through the new culverts.

TRTC is a **total volunteer** organization and as such **WE NEED YOUR HELP** to get this job done! The speed of getting this work completed depends directly on how much help we get to do it. If you like to dig in the dirt or just want some great upper body conditioning we have job security for you!
