

TRTC - Regular Meeting – 3 Jan 2011

President Dilys Bowman called the meeting to order at 7:30.

Minutes for December reviewed and approved by voice vote.

Treasurer's report for December reviewed and approved by voice vote.

Walt Shekrota discussed the need for better communications between walkers, runners, and bicyclists on area trails. He gave as an example his own experience of overtaking a runner who then turned into Walt, knocking down Walt and his bike. Dan spoke of BPAC/DOST/TRTC concerns about this communications problem and displayed a proposed sign. Dan will talk to Durham about creation and installation of better signs.

Eagle Spur – Discussion of proposed NC Wildlife maintenance agreement. Bill will make suggested changes and send to NC Wildlife contact person.

Durham – Herndon Park connector: Bill passed around the Landscape Architect's drawing. Several changes were suggested in order to clarify various items.

Durham – Fayetteville Road Trailhead: Trash Can may be needed – bags of trash are being left beside PortAJon.

Durham Phase E: Discussion of Gates/Bollards – 42 inches should be minimum opening for horses and trikes.

Other Items: Elections next month – Jeff Pinnow has moved to Charlotte.
Dilys will be moving to Toronto later in 2011.
Bob Kruhm volunteered to join the Board.
